

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pavia 304SS Slide Shower

Mains Pressure Installation Only

ATTENTION PLUMBER

For best performance and to maintain customer satisfaction, please follow the guidelines below:

- Thoroughly flush all plumbing lines before beginning installation.
- Installation must comply with the AS/NZS 3500 standards.
- The maximum allowable operating pressure for any building is 500 kPa. Exceeding this limit can result in water hammer, premature wear on fixtures and appliances, and excessive noise throughout the system.
- A pressure-limiting valve is required if the supply pressure exceeds 500 kPa.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- This product is designed for high-pressure water systems only.
- It is not suitable for gravity-fed cylinders or low/unequal pressure installations.
- Minimum operating pressure: 150 kPa
- Maximum operating pressure: 500 kPa
- Maximum hot water temperature: 50°C
- If water temperature exceeds 50°C, an approved tempering valve must be installed.

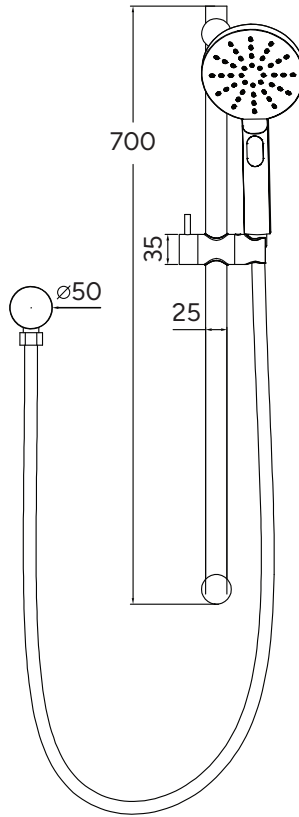
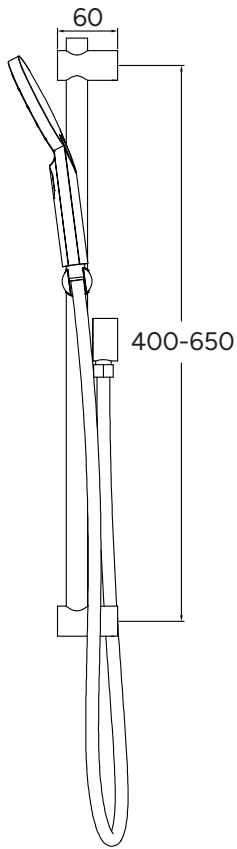

BRACKET INSTALLATION

1. Measure and mark out the top and bottom mounting points to fix the mounting brackets.
 - A. The top bracket allows adjustment up to 650mm centres.
 - B. Ensure all marks are level and correctly aligned.
2. Drill holes and fix the brackets in place.
 - A. It is recommended to apply silicone sealant around the screw fixing points.

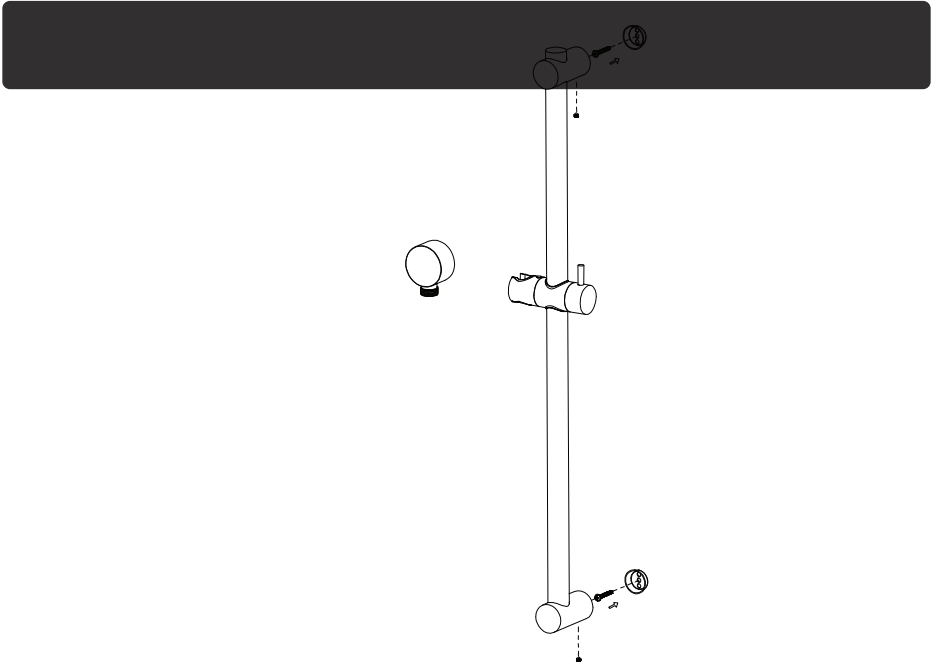
*All measurements are in millimetres. Sizes are nominal.



RAIL INSTALLATION

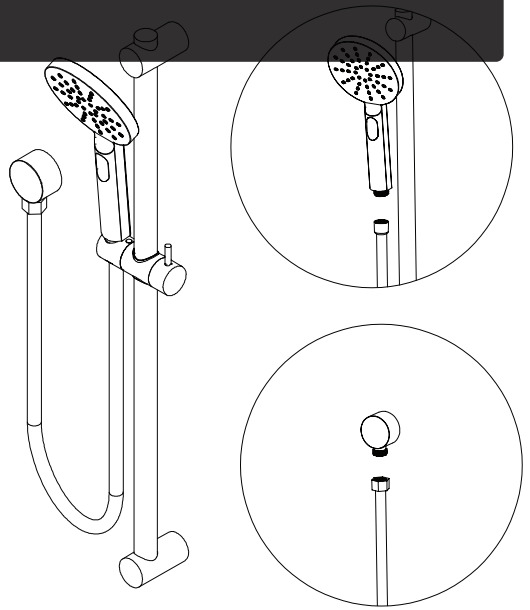
Push the slide rail onto the brackets and tighten the grub screws into the groove of each bracket.

Do not over-tighten.



WALL ELBOW, HOSE & HAND SHOWER INSTALLATION:

1. Fit the wall elbow onto the ½" BSP male water outlet (not supplied).
2. Screw the hand shower onto the tapered end of the hose by hand, ensuring the sealing washer is correctly positioned.
3. Connect the nut end of the hose to the water outlet, confirm the washer is in place, and gently tighten with a spanner.



- Clean regularly using a soft cloth and mild, non-abrasive soap solution.
- Avoid using acidic, alkaline, or abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals, as they can damage the surface finish and internal components.
- After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with fresh water and dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spotting and mineral build-up.
- Periodically check all visible connections for signs of leaks, looseness, or wear.
- Ensure the hot and cold supply pressures remain within the manufacturer's recommended limits to protect the product and prolong service life.

- Components such as cartridges, seals, and aerators may have separate warranty terms or may be considered consumable items.
- If a defect is confirmed, the manufacturer will repair, replace, or supply replacement parts at their discretion. Labour, removal, or reinstallation costs may not be covered.
